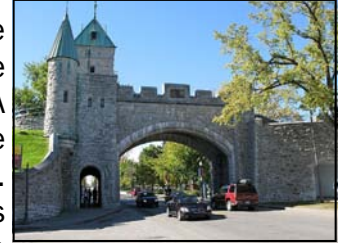

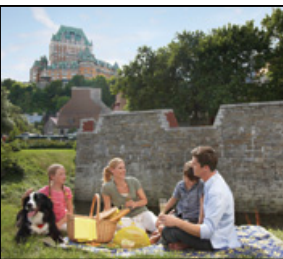

## Les Chemins Invisibles (The Invisible Paths) by Cirque du Soleil

## Images Mill by Robert Lepage



This mega-production will take your breath away. The outdoor projection screen—actually the huge silos in the Old Port—is over 1,970 feet wide and almost 100 feet tall. It’s no surprise that The Image Mill earned a place in the *Guinness Book of World Records*. Through the use of cutting-edge technology, images are crystal clear, with definition that surpasses HD quality and demonstrates mind-blowing visual effects. The story transports us through four centuries of Québec City’s history in four movements: waterways, road building, rail expansion, and air travel. The show begins at 9:30 pm and lasts about 50 minutes. This show is free.

This unique experience begins with a panoramic elevator ascending to 600 feet above sea level.
