Tuesday, May 27

Your journey begins with a departure from Woodsville, Franconia, or Plymouth, punctuated by rest breaks and a lunch stop along the way. As midday approaches, enjoy lunch on your own in the charming town of Seneca Falls. Then, immerse yourself in history at the Women's Rights National Historic Park, where the echoes of progress resonate within the walls of Wesleyan Chapel—the birthplace of the first Women's Rights Convention in the United States—led by a passionate local ranger. Tonight, indulge in a culinary treat at New York Kitchen, where dinner is not just a meal but an immersive experience. Delight in a cooking demonstration by our skilled chef. *(Meals: B, D)*

Thursday, May 29

After a hearty breakfast, venture to the renowned Corning Museum of Glass for an enchanting tour, witnessing the timeless artistry and innovation of glassmaking. Lunch is on your own at the Glass Market Café. Later, sip and savor the finest Finger Lakes wines at a local winery before setting sail on the tranquil waters of Seneca Lake aboard the “Seneca Spirit”. The captain tells tales of the lakes and takes us to the base of a thundering waterfall as it enters the lake. Hear of the Native Americans of the region while cruising the deep waters. Your day culminates with an included memorable dinner at Seneca Harbor Station, offering breathtaking water views and the majestic landscapes surrounding it. *(Meals: B, D)*

Friday, May 30

Reservations & Payments:

Reservations will be accepted subject to availability at the time of a request. Payment can be made in person, sent by mail, or by phone. Checks, Cash, VISA or MasterCard are accepted. Make checks payable to WGSB Guaranty Tours; P.O. Box 266; Woodsville, NH 03785. A completed registration form and a per person deposit are due within 5 days of confirming your tour reservation. The deposit amount is listed on each brochure. Day trips require payment in full for a confirmed reservation.

Non-members are able to make a tour reservation after February 1st of that travel year and will join the tour at the regular deluxe tour price.

The final payment is due 60 days prior to departure. WGSB will confirm reservations on a first-come, first-served basis. If the tour you're interested in is fully booked, you'll be offered to place your name on a waiting list. Guaranty Tours will notify you if space becomes available.

Cancellation:

Deposits are not refundable after March 28, 2025.
All other payments are non-refundable after their due date.
Trip and travel insurance are highly recommended.

Trip and Travel Insurance:

In the event of a cancellation, without travel insurance, name changes are permitted with WGSB approval. While WGSB will assist in finding a suitable substitute, it is the responsibility of the person cancelling to find a suitable replacement; gain approval; and negotiate the cost. To protect other members from price increases, due to decreased enrollment, the cancellation policy will be strictly enforced.

Participants are urged to review their insurance requirements with their personal insurance agent or consider a policy available from Allianz Travel Insurance. Allianz provides coverage for cancelled and interrupted trips, medical costs, travel accidents and lost/stolen baggage.
